It has come to our attention that a number of you may have received unsolicited calls, emails or correspondence purporting to represent, or be assisting, the administrators of LCF, specifically in reference to dividend payments or recompense of investments. Please be advised that any emails from info@londoncapitalfinanceuk.com are **not** authorised by the administrators of LCF and should be disregarded as an attempted scam. The LCF administration team will only contact Bondholders from the usual email address, or by telephone only where a Bondholder has specifically requested a call back.

The use of the registered office address within these communications, of 25 Moorgate, is a deliberate attempt to convince Bondholders that the correspondence is genuine.

We strongly recommend that you do not respond to these communications, or provide any personal details, that may be requested from you.
